# Erickson Brings Home Two Construction Excellence Awards for 2009

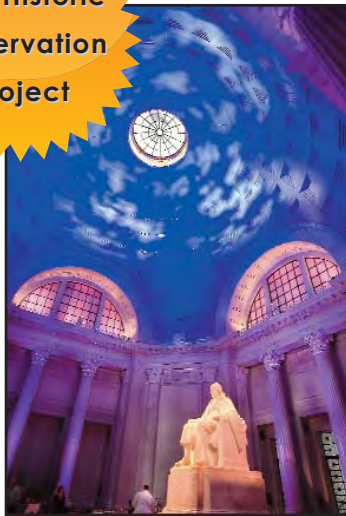

## Franklin Institute

### Franklin & Jordan Halls Renovation and Exterior Restoration

**Best Historic Preservation Project**



As part of its "Inspire Science!" plan, the Franklin Institute awarded longtime partner C. Erickson & Sons the task -- and privilege -- of carrying out the restoration of its historic Jordan Hall, and Franklin Hall, which houses the Benjamin Franklin National Memorial.

The project called for the full historical refurbishment of the Franklin Hall interior,

including protection of the marble flooring, as well as the Franklin statue itself, cleaning of all marble, limestone and pre-cast cement, restoration of bronze doors, grates, railings and gates, pane replacement for the four half-moon windows overlooking the Hall, pane replacement of the glass oculus at the peak of the 82-foot dome, and gold re-leafing around the oculus.

Additional to this work was the installation of a brand new audio-visual projection and lighting and presentation system, as well as the cleaning and restoration of the Franklin Institute's exterior.

### PECO Green Roof

**Best Green Project Honorable Mention**



Erickson was contracted for the installation of PECO's new Green Roof for PECO's corporate headquarters.

The project sprawled 48,000 square feet, and -- after removal of the existing roof, and structural upgrades to the base surface -- entailed the installation of a four-layered green-roof assembly.

Stacked layers include an underlying drainage board with leak detection system, root guard, and three inches of a supportive growth medium.
